### General info

1. We are interested in any materials or items that can be used in an art, craft or play context.
2. Materials must be **clean** and **safe**.
3. The more colourful the better, particularly with regard to paper, fabric and plastics.
4. Strange, exotic, and unusual materials are our “grail”!
5. If the scrap is appropriate we can take large quantities and act as distributor to the UK network of 105 scrapstores.
6. If you can deliver – great! If not - we can collect.
7. **We do not accept** any food containers (even if they have been washed out) or electrical equipment - unless listed.
8. **We can** take donations of suitable household items (particularly fabrics) but can only accept them if sorted into different types – we can not accept large bags of mixed scrap types.
9. **This list is incomplete! If you’ve got something that’s not listed here and you think it would be useful, call us. Call us if you need to scrap any quantity of suitable materials.**
